Thank you for your interest in learning Korean! The Korean Language Program at Smith College offers courses for four different levels from beginners to advanced learners of Korean. While some of you may have not had a chance to learn Korean yet and will take KOR101 (Elementary Korean) in the fall semester, some come to Smith with experience and proficiency in Korean. If you have previous experience with the language, you should take the Placement Test before registering for a Korean course in order to determine the appropriate level for your learning.

The Placement Test is in an online format and consists of four parts:

- Part I. Placement questionnaire
- Part II. Grammar and reading test
- Part III. Hand-written essay
- Part IV. Interview with Korean instructors via Zoom

The test will be accessible after Monday, August 3 by the link below. Please complete by Friday, August 14, 2026 11:59 EDT.

Your oral interview will be held August 17-21, 2026. Your course placement will be determined by the assessment of all four parts of the test.
