Smith College Deadline for Application to Host School/University:	Fall Semester: April 1st, Spring Semester: September 1st
Payments (Students must confirm with their host school/university that Smith is responsible for all tuition, room and board expenses)	
Tuition Deposit Required?	No
Accommodation Deposit Covered by Smith?	Residential Colleges send deposit invoice directly to Smith as a prepayment. Other housing deposits are paid by student as they are refundable.
Tuition:	Tuition Invoicing sent directly to Smith
Accommodation:	Students should notify their housing that Smith College is their sponsoring institution so they will send invoicing directly to Smith. If invoicing is sent directly to the student they must forward it on to the Study Abroad Coordinator
Accommodation Expectations:	Must apply for university-affiliated housing by posted deadline. Take the application for the Residential Colleges seriously as only 1 in 3 students get accepted. The Residential Colleges recommended for Smith students are Janet Clark Hall, St Mary's College and International House. Students should also apply for back up housing at either Student Village, RMIT Village or Semester in Australia. For these 3 options, students should choose "mid-range" priced accommodation - not the most expensive and not the cheapest, but somewhere in between. In most cases, mid-range will be rooms in flats where you may or may not have your own bathroom (aka: en suite) and where you'll have to cook for yourself (aka: self-catered).
Accommodation Application Deadline at	Housing for semester 1 (Feb-June): November 1st;
University of Melbourne: Visa:	Housing for semester 2 (July-Nov): April 15th All students applying directly to host
